3. All exhibits should, as far as possible, be handed in to Newlands Centre on Friday 6th September between 7.00 and 8.30 p.m. or on Saturday 7th September between 8.30 and 10.00 am. Judging commences at 10.15 am
4. Vases available in Hall.
5. All envelopes marked with class number and containing named entrant to be handed in with exhibit. Where applicable, envelopes to be attached to jars with elastic bands and pinned firmly to cakes or plates.
6. No entry money refunded for articles which have been entered but which are not exhibited.
7. No tinned or packet mixes to be used.
8. In all matters, the decision of the judges shall be final and no protest will be entertained.
9. All articles on show not intended for sale must be clearly marked "Not for Sale" and owners of these exhibits are requested to remove them just before the sale.
10. Not more than one entry per exhibitor per class.
11. The committee will not accept responsibility in the event of loss or damage of any exhibits.
